Holiday Season Vegetable CSA

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a partnership with a farm in which you purchase a share of the season's harvest, rather than a specific item of produce. Harvests vary seasonally, depending on the weather and other factors.

Our winter CSA share will include storage crops (potatoes, beets, turnips, cabbage, carrots, radishes, sweet potatoes, onions, and apples) as well as freshly picked salad and cooking greens.

Shareholders select the vegetables they will take home as their allotment.

We offer two share size options: ten, or fifteen items per pickup.

An "item" of produce would consist of a pound of roots, or a head, bunch, or bag of greens.
